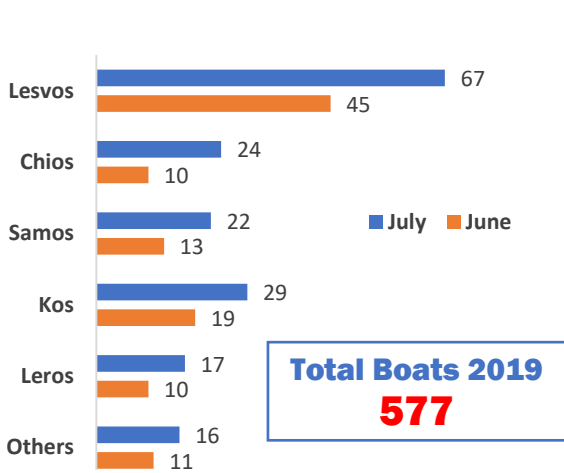




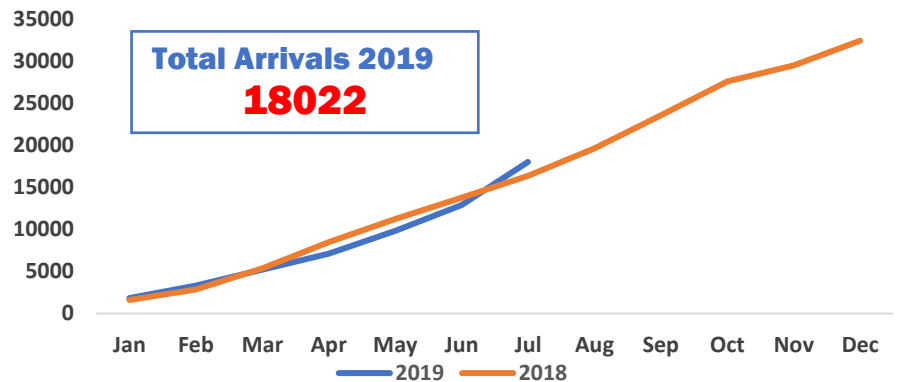

Boats Arrived Islands

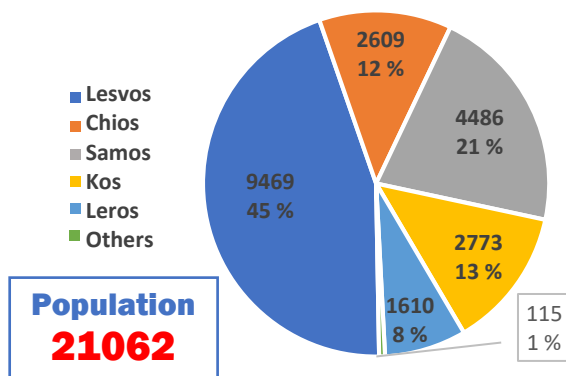


People Arrived Aegean Islands



In 2019, people arriving is up 10.1%, compared to 2018. In July, 175 boats made it to the Greek islands, carrying a total of 5099 people. Arrivals has increased 63.6% compared to June, boats arriving is up 62%. Demographics on the islands: Men 42%, Women 22% and Children 36%

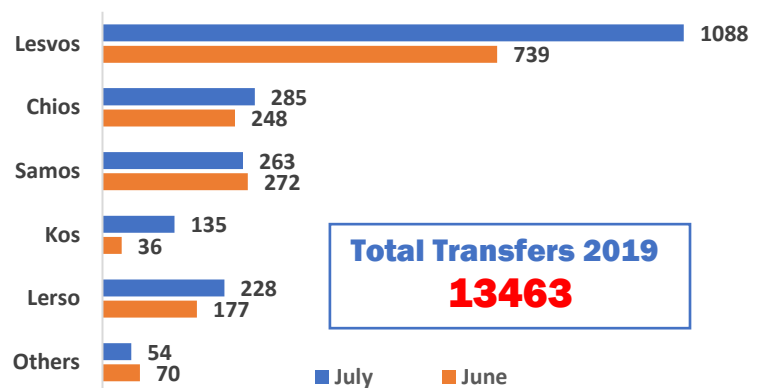
Population on Greek Islands



Official capacity on the islands is 9209 people. Today's population exceeds this by 128.7%.

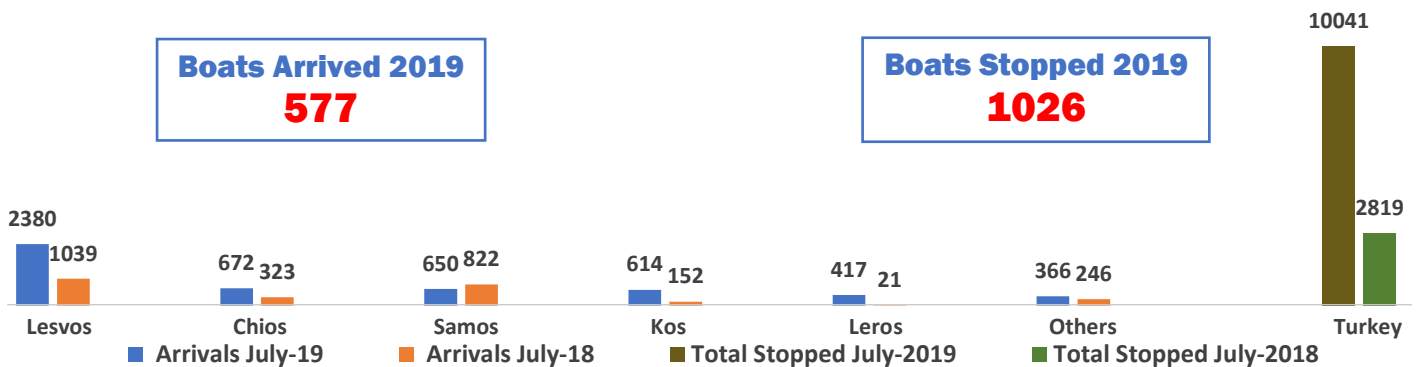
Total transfers was 2053 people in July, arrivals was 5099, population has increased by approximately 3600 people this last month on the Greek Islands.

Transfers to Mainland



In July 2053 people were transported to mainland, from the Greek islands. Transfers have increased 33.1% compared to June, when 1542 people were transported.

People Arriving on Aegean Islands & Stopped By TCG/Police



Total arrivals are up by 10.1% compared to same period in 2018. 493 boats started their trip towards the Greek islands in July, carrying a total of 15140 people. 175 boats made the trip, carrying a total of 5099 people, the rest, 318 boats, 10041 people, were arrested by the Turkish Coast guard and Police. In 2019 1026 boats have been stopped on their way towards Greece, 32488 people have been arrested. Both boats arriving on the Greek island, and boats stopped by TCG/Police is the highest registered since 2015, population is rapidly increasing on the islands.
