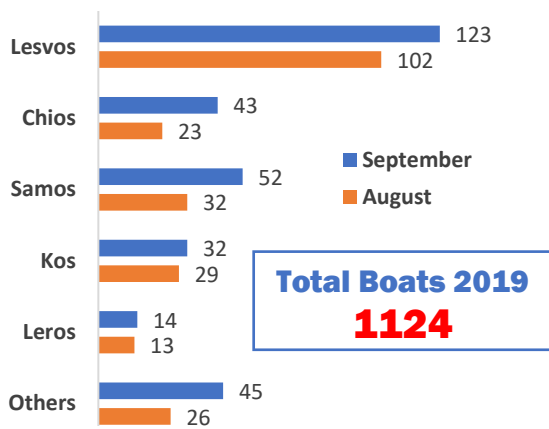

Boats Arrived Islands

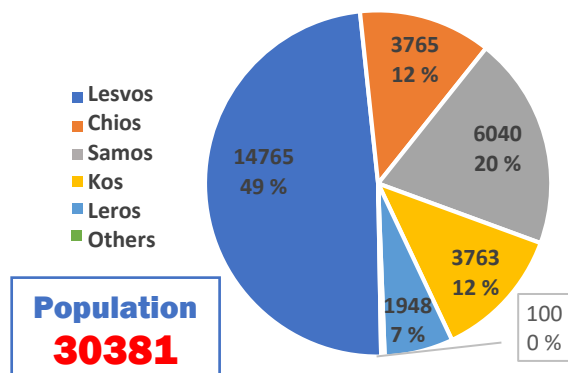


People Arrived Aegean Islands



In 2019, people arriving is up 55%, compared to 2018. In September 309 boats made it to the Greek islands, carrying a total of 10737 people. Arrivals has increased 35.6% compared to August, boats arriving is up 37.3%. Demographics on the islands: Men 43%. Women 22% and Children 35%

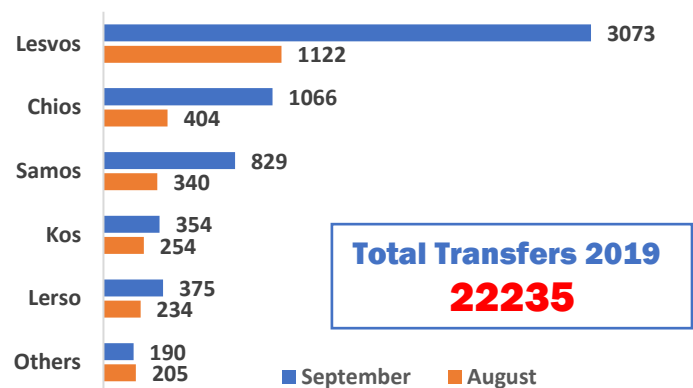
Population on Greek Islands



Official capacity on the islands is 9209 people. Today's population exceeds this by 229.9%.

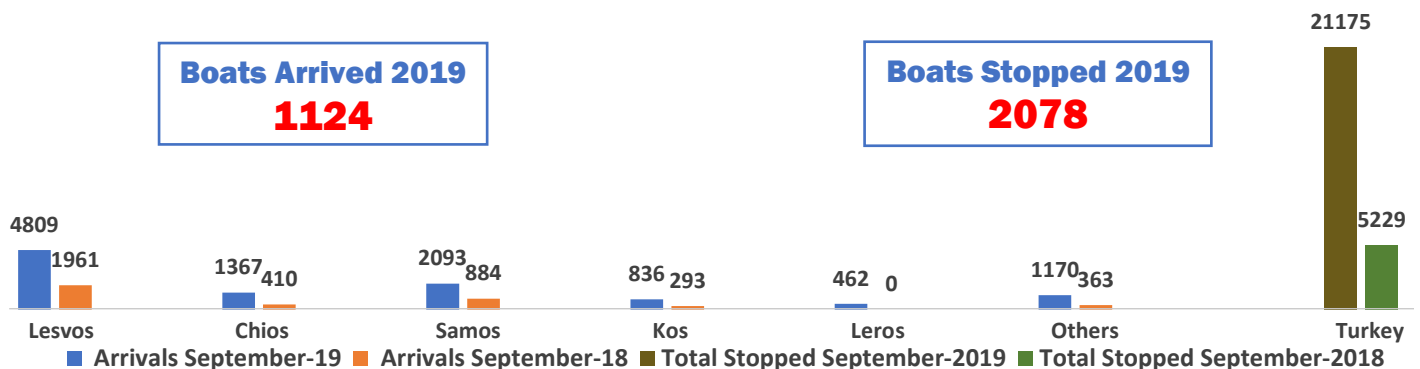
Total transfers were 5399 people in September, arrivals were 10737, population has increased by approximately 4530 people this last month on the Greek Islands.

Transfers to Mainland



In September 5399 people were transported to mainland, from the Greek islands. Transfers have increased 111% compared to August, when 2559 people were transported.

People Arriving on Aegean Islands & Stopped By TCG/Police



Total arrivals are up by 174% compared to same period in 2018. 908 boats started their trip towards the Greek islands in September, carrying a total of 31912 people. 309 boats made the trip, carrying a total of 10737 people, the rest, 599 boats, 21175 people, were arrested by the Turkish Coast guard and Police. In 2019 2078 boats have been stopped on their way towards Greece, 67859 people have been arrested. Both boats arriving on the Greek island, and boats stopped by TCG/Police is the highest registered since 2015, population is increasing beyond control on the islands.
