


MONTHLY STATISTICS JAN 2020

People Arrived on Aegean islands




In 2020, people arriving is up 68.4%, compared to 2019. In January 84 boats made it to the Greek islands, carrying a total of 3096 people. Arrivals has decreased 50.3% compared to December, boats arriving is down 52.8%. Demographics on the islands: Men 45%, Women 22% and Children 33%

Boats stopped by TCG/Police



Total arrivals are up by 68.4% compared to same period in 2019. 256 boats started their trip towards the Greek islands in January, carrying a total of 9265 people. 84 boats made the trip, carrying a total of 3096 people, the rest, 172 boats, 6169 people, were arrested by the Turkish Coast guard and Police.

Total numbers so far this year



In 2020 172 boats have been stopped on their way towards Greece, 6169 people have been arrested. Both boats arriving on the Greek island, and boats stopped by TCG/Police is extremely high compared to previous years, population on the islands is almost at 42000.





Arrivals and transfers by island

In January 3600 people were transported to mainland, from the Greek islands. Transfers have decreased 14.2% compared to December, when 4194 people were transported. In 12 months population on the Aegean islands has increased by 185%, from 14673 to 41816 people. Greek government's efforts to reduce population on the islands has failed massively.



Population on each island



Official capacity on the islands is 9209 people. Today's population exceeds this by 354%. Despite low arrival numbers in January, population on the Greek islands remains high. Authorities seems reluctant to reduce population, while thousands are suffering on the islands.
