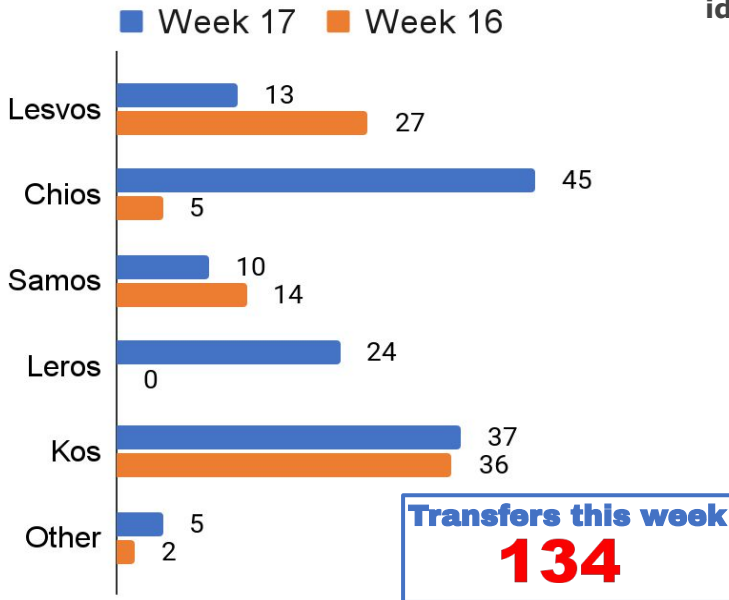

### Boats Stopped TCG/Police

**31** BOATS  
**826** PEOPLE

A total of 35 boats started their trip towards the Greek Aegean Islands, carrying a total of 895 people. 31 boats were stopped/pushback, and 69 people was registered on the Greek Islands. So far this year 376 boats have been picked up by The Turkish Coast Guard and Police, 11.057 people. 1381 people have been registered as arrived on the Greek islands on 88 boat, so far in 2022. This number should have been much higher, due to pushbacks performed by the Hellenic coast guard.

### Transfers to Mainland



Transfers to mainland have increased 59.5% compared to last week, official population on the islands is 2311 people. In the last 30 days population on the islands has decreased by 701 people. Demographics on the islands: Men 60%, Women 13%, Children 27%(40% younger than 10 years)

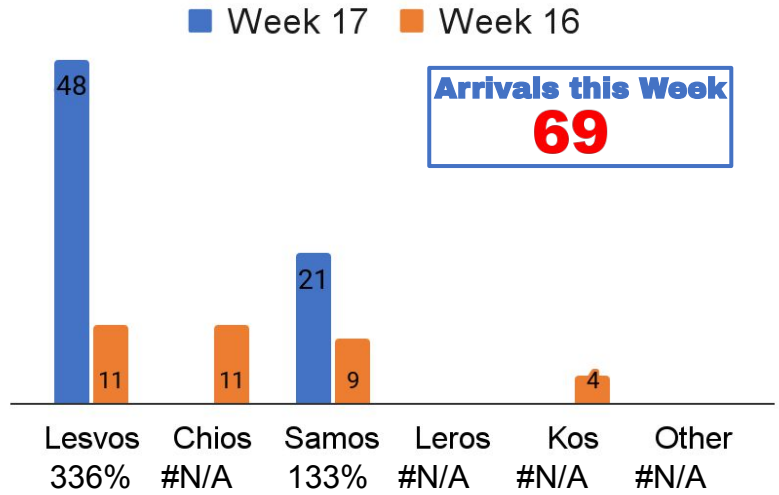

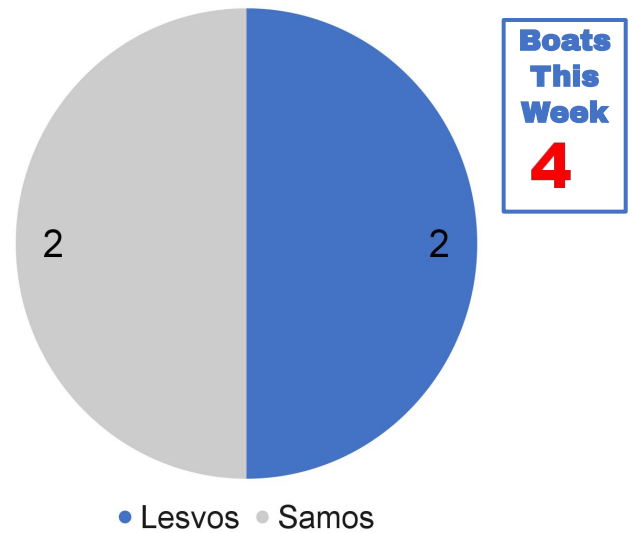


### People Arrived on Aegean islands



Arrivals have increased 97.1% compared to last Week. Registered boats arriving on the islands is identical with last week when 4 boats arrived. Total number of boats started is also identical with last week when 35 boats started.

### Boats Arrived on islands



This week TCG/police have picked up 31 boats, 88.6%, 4 boats, 11.4%, made it to the Greek islands. So far this year 88 boat have arrived on the Islands, 81% have been picked up by TCG
